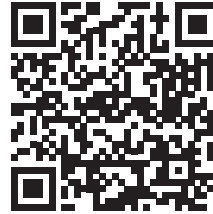

Through the course of this conference, attendees will become better informed about evidence-based science regarding dietary issues and popular diets, endocrine topics, and sleep disorders.
