Installation of Officers and Awards Event

Daron W. Gersch, MD, FAAFP, and AAFP Vice Speaker will install officers of the board and address the membership on Friday, May 5 at 10:00 am. On Saturday, May 6 at 12:00 pm, we will honor our Idaho Family Physician of the Year for 2023 and present our Advocacy Award.

Exhibits

This year's event will include an Exhibitor Hall and over one-dozen exhibitors. The Exhibitor Hall officially opens in the morning on May 5 and breaks are built into the agenda for you to visit our exhibitors. A total of 2.5 hours of time for visiting exhibitors is built into the program and exhibitor visits will be incentivized with two raffles to be drawn at the end of each day's program. Please make a special effort to visit all the exhibit booths.

Learning objectives

Through the course of this conference, participants will experience a review of the findings of critical articles and studies over the past 24 months in outpatient and inpatient care. They will learn dermatology tips relevant to Family Medicine, receive detailed information about important nuances in newborn care (prophylaxis and vitamin K deficiency), and learn new tools and practices to support patients with suicidal ideation. Attendees will also learn about the management of hypertension in pregnancy, best treatments for adult ADHD, and participate in a detailed workshop on implicit bias and bystander training for medical professionals. Those attending the conference will receive information about the clinical impacts of Idaho's reproductive health laws, caring for gender diverse patients, reframing, and treating obesity in Primary Care and will get to participate in a workshop utilizing Point of Care Ultrasound for musculoskeletal issues.
